European Summer School Ravensbrück 2009:

Under German Occupation: Gender Politics and Racism during World War II- Poland, France, Italy (30.08.-4.09.2009)

Seventy years after the attack on Poland and the beginning of World War II, the fifth European Summer School Ravensbrück will focus on the German occupation of Europe. A comparative look at Poland, France and Italy will examine the differences and similarities of German occupation policies and the daily life under occupation during the Second World War.

Postgraduate and early career researchers working on a project related to the topics of this year's Summer School who would like to present their work are invited to apply until June, 30th.

We are especially interested in projects about the former concentration camp Ravensbrück, its satellite camps, about the concentration camp for young women Uckermark or the Siemens camp. Also welcome are projects which are analysing questions of commemoration and commemoration politics.

All elected researchers will have the possibility to present their project in form of a poster or in a colloquium. The presentation is possible in English or German.
